## Puffin Facts 5: Eggs and hatching



Puffins lay a single egg between late April and May.

Eggs are usually white but may be tinged lilac.

Eggs are incubated by both parents for 36-45 days.

The chick will then spend between 34 to 60 days on the nest being fed by both parents. (This time depends on how abundant the food supply is)
