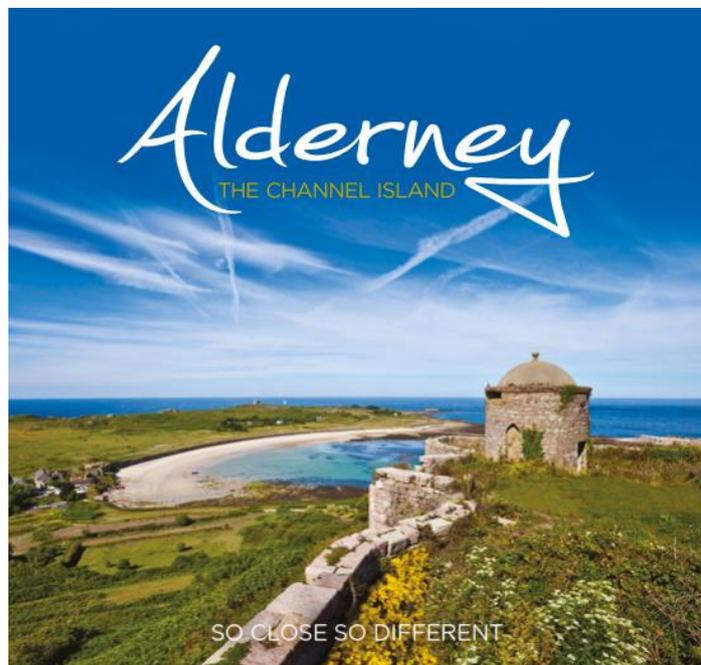
Visit Alderney – Create a brochure

Brochures give the reader a message in a small amount of space. As well as being informative, leaflets often try to persuade the reader to do something.

Where you'll find brochures:

- Museums and galleries make leaflets to tell people what's on.
- Shops, hotels and restaurants print leaflets to advertise the things they sell.
- Some leaflets are designed to tell you about a campaign to get your support - for example, to save a building or tidy up a park.
- Your school probably makes leaflets telling parents what's going on and how good your school is.

Brochures come in all shapes and sizes, but they all have to tell the reader as much as possible in a small space whilst grabbing their attention.



Brochures should be filled with facts. It needs to tell the reader everything they need to know and **persuade** them to do something.

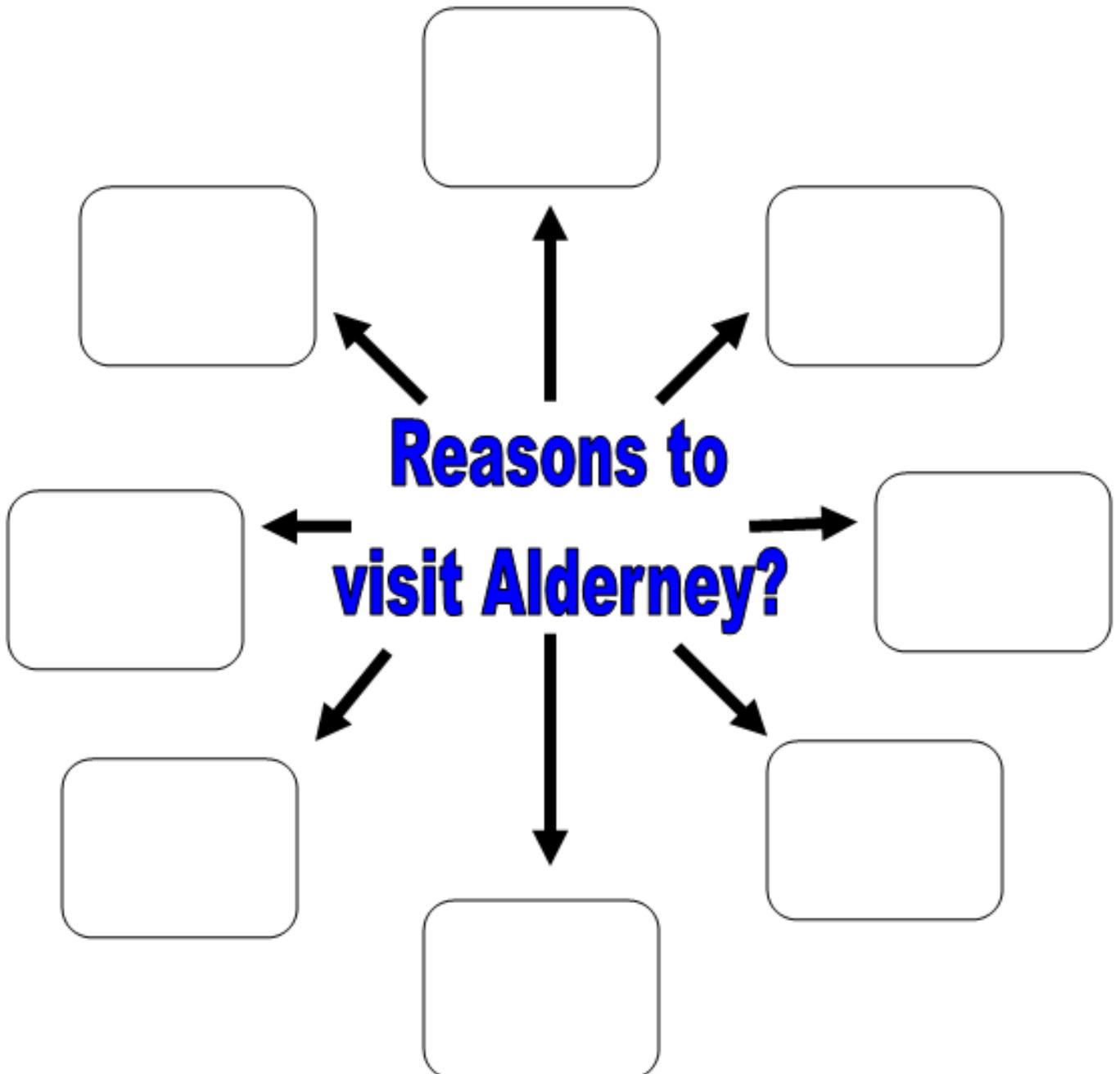

Comic Life is a comic desktop publishing computer application developed by Plasq, The app is designed to create comic pages using digital photos. Users can drag and drop photos from their libraries, finders, directly from web pages or other programs. Comic Life has an integrated camera feature that allows the user to snap a picture and add it directly to a comic.
